We wish to keep the short end of the bar clear for ordering/collection and payment and would ask you to keep this area as clear as possible to allow people to pass safely.

At the moment we will continue to open Friday and Saturday lunchtime and evenings and all day Sunday – table bookings are still very much advised.

We are changing our menu slightly -

Friday night – we will concentrate on our speciality curries, chilli, burgers, pizzas, fish and chips all available to eat-in or takeaway.

Saturday night – a chance to try our lamb, chicken and pork speciality dishes and a selection of fish and vegetarian/vegan recipes.
